Subject: drogheda roads

Working in our lady of lourdes hospital in Drogheda and travelling daily from Ardee can often entail one hour journey each way, as traffic is backed up from 8.00 a.m til after 9.00 am, try getting out of designated car park, can take from 25 minutes to 60 minutes, from 4.00 pm til 6.00 pm any day, only one lane into car park and one lane out for three separate areas, plus new Psychiatric unit, don't know how many spaces there are in the park, or how many vehicles are parked there all day

At present people with hospital appointments are turning up late as they cannot find a parking place in Cross lanes hospital car park, or any roads adjacent to hospital as these local roads are used by hospital staff who cannot park in hospital car park either,,, when planning for future please build or widen present roads and out of town car parks, even park and ride facilities out of town,, we don't care as long as travel time is reduced,,, more houses more roads, new houses have been built in this area, and all this egresses out onto Cross Lanes at same time as schools and DIFE college, there is no plan for emergency exit in car park either, even if there was an exit for north bound traffic and south bound traffic it would have the waste of time and fuel while trying to get out of this car park.
