Hi all,

The following project cost estimate is €4-6 billion. The distance from Ballycastle to Rathlin Island to Scotland is a small distance by comparison to international standards and this China project.

On the basis of a 70 year life span of the project, its costs €120 million per year including maintenance.

Assuming China Investment Bank fund the project and the Governments of Scotland, Belfast and Dublin contribute the €120m a year on a shared basis, this €40 million a year cost will open up an economic corridor and land connection between these nations.
