So some things I think Ireland really needs are:

- To stop giving away our fishing and natural gas.
- Invest in green energy
- Invest in green transport and increase cycle infrastructure and safety measures
- END (not reform) Direct Provision
- Repeal of the 8th Amendment and introduction of a system to facilitate free, safe and legal abortions.
- Build Social Housing
- Work towards a progressive taxation system that can facilitate a universal basic wage.
- Increase legal access to the outdoors (organisations like Keep Ireland Open work on this)
- Plant more native woodland rather than Coillte evergreen forests.
- Reform RTE to be less conservative in its output. RTE has so many great aspects but doesn't appear to be willing to take risks. Shows like I Am Immigrant or documentaries on political corruption were brilliant. RTE is a failing organisation, but is our national broadcaster. Instead of raising fees and selling land, make changes to how the organisation produces work and look for innovative solutions to make its output more interesting and relevant to the Irish Cultural experience.
- Introduce a National Health System and remove private healthcare
- Nationalisations of natural monopolies.
- Remove the Church from the constitution and from the education system. Removal of Church from public life and hospitals.
- US out of Shannon
- Better maternity and paternity pay, alongside cheaper childcare facilities
- More funding for the Arts
- FREE EDUCATION for all, including asylum seekers
- Nationalisation process for longstanding undocumented migrants.
- Increase the influence of socialism and reduce the neoliberal policies that successive governments have been implementing.
